OUR HISTORY

The concept for the Keller Market House began with the 2011 **Fairfield Growing** Agricultural Economic Development Plan. Through the work of the Fairfield County Local Food Council, an Ohio not-for-profit corporation was formed in May 2015. In July 2015, the current location was acquired through the Fairfield County Land Bank's repurposing program. The building was named the "Keller Market House" to honor the Keller Grocery that operated there from 1867 to 1914, and opened its doors for business in May 2016.

In 2018, we assumed management of the Lancaster Farmers Market, building an even stronger local food system for our producers and community.

EVENTS

We started the year off strong with a **Volunteer Clean Up Day** to set the stage for our renovation process.

In April, we held a **Taste of the Market** to introduce six of our newest food vendors, and **Earth Day** with a healthy soil demo and plant & seed swap.

For the Lancaster Festival in July, we hosted a Lancaster Festival **Low Brass Quartet** concert and local artist Carol Buccilla for **ArtWalk**.

And we kicked off the holiday season with our annual **Friendsgiving** gathering for our Friend of the Market Members, where they got a sneak peek tour of the renovations.



FUNDRAISERS

MARKET BARS

We held three Market Bar celebrations at the Lancaster Farmers Market this year, where we throw a party and serve seasonal drinks. Downtown neighbors Double Edge Brewing Co. and O'Huid's Gaelic Pub helped us out and the Lancaster Fire Department even made a cameo visit at our Fall Finale.

FARM + KITCHEN

We expanded our signature Farm + Kitchen fundraiser to spring and fall in 2023, with six one-of-a-kind gatherings taking place around the Lancaster area. Unique venues included a historic wine cellar, a family farm, a retreat center, and a restored barn.



PRODUCE PERKS

In 2023, we improved our Produce Perks program by adopting the green tokens familiar to our farmers market SNAP customers for use inside the Keller Market as well.

These "perks" do double duty for our community, providing free fruits & veggies to SNAP shoppers and increasing sales for our local produce farmers.

This year, our Produce Perks program grew by 57%, with morethan \$7000 in Produce Perks redeemed between the two markets.

WIC FARMERS MARKET NUTRITION PROGRAM

We added WIC FMNP acceptance as a farmers market this year, meaning that WIC recipients could use their FMNP vouchers with any of our fruit & vegetable growers.

Our Fairfield County WIC Nutritionists joined us to distribute these vouchers to WIC participants right at the market as well as provide resources on healthy eating.



For the first time, we held three scheduled Kids' Days at the farmers market. All three of these summer markets were well attended by families and featured a variety of free activities and resources, including Storytime with the Fairfield County District Library and nutrition info from OSU Extension.

Thanks to a grant from the Fairfield County
Foundation's Youth Advisory Committee, we were
also able to launch a "**Seed Money**" program where
kids were able to receive a packet of coupons worth
\$10 and shop with the market vendors of their choice
for free.






GROCERY EXPANSION

Our biggest endeavor in 2023 was renovations to our historic building to expand our grocery operations. This project was made possible by a grant of \$195,724 from **America's Healthy Food Financing Initiative** of the USDA.

The rear of our building has been transformed with new work spaces for our vendors and staff and a dedicated delivery entrance from Chestnut Street. We've added three new freezers and three new refrigerators for expanded capacity. And our retail area will get new grocery shelving to set the stage to offer even more local foods.
